This guide assists international students in relation to the COVID-19 related requirements of the Australian Government, as well as providing information on Equinim College's practices for student safety.

1. Are the borders for travel into Australia open?

That webpage gives a link to the Digital Passenger Declaration which all travellers must complete within 72 hours before departure to Australia. In that declaration, you must provide your health information and declaration of your vaccination status and COVID-19 test result.
